

Open your MODEL in Photoshop (Drag your file on Photoshop icon)

Now we need to work with contrast and make black parts more deep

Image-Adjustment- Curves


When you see IMPORT PDF window, just press OK

Drag your DRESS on the top of the MODEL

Press SHIFT and make your dress smaller by dragging the Corners of the image, its should fit perfectly on the model



Drag dots on the graphic to find perfect balance.



Press ENTER to place your dress




Now you have 2 working layers



Choose tool brush, click on layer with suit 1 time to unlock it




Select all your dress with tool Quick selection



Now we need to make it black and white. Stay on layer with dress. Choose Image-Adjustments-Black and white

Click ok when you see a new window




We need to blur our shadows Filter-Blur- Gaussian blur




Radius 5 pix



Hide level with model








Use step backward 2 times

Put your print on the top of your dress Stretch it




Make opacity of your print lower 45%



Press CMD +T and choose ——wrap tool




Shape your print around your dress




Make opacity 100%


Place your print. Press enter Then Filter- Distort-Displace



Press OK









Select your dress with quick selection


Choose our dress in PSD
